

- 90 Days POR -

Proof Of Residency

Federal regulations require all Resident Aliens and Visa Holders to prove that they have been in the state for 90 days before they can purchase a firearm of any kind. This is on top of all the other requirements. If a Resident Alien or Visa Holder leaves the country, then he or she must wait 90 days before purchasing a firearm.

Resident Aliens need:

- Valid CDL/ID - **If your CDL/CID does NOT have your Current Residential Address - See "KNOW YOUR CUSTOMER"**
- Handgun Buyers - CA POR for handgun buyers - See "PN242 CA - Handgun Proof Of Residency"

We require you to bring in 4 months POR (the last 4 months).

We want to see the postmark or billing date. (We must have verifiable proof of issue date or mailing date.)

We want proof that you have been getting these documents at your residential address.

If you have moved in the last 4 months but have stayed in the state of CA, then you can use more than one address to prove that you have been residing in CA. You need to prove that you have lived in CA for more than 90 days immediately before the registration of your firearm. You can mix and match the below documents (one for each of the last 4 months) to prove residency. However, it makes the whole process more difficult when you mix and match documents with different start and end dates. All of the documents together **MUST** cover the last 90 days; **there cannot be any time gaps.**

Approved Documents to show 90 days POR:

- Utility Bills
- Major Credit Card Bills
- Cell Phone Bills
- Current Bank Statements
- Monthly Insurance Bills
- Mortgage Statements/Bills that were mailed to you
- Loan Statements / Bills that were mailed to you
- Rent Receipts
- Verified Residential Lease (See Separate Document PN483 - Leases and Rental Agreements -)
- Personal Property Tax Bills
- Documents issued by Federal, State, or Local Government Agencies
- Government Issued First Class Mail (must see post mark and have discernible date)
- Insurance policies
- Mailed Pay Checks
